V.H.F. Convertors

Further to my comments last month on the DL6HA Convertor for use on 70 MHz, I have modified a board down to this frequency and it works very well. It has a measured gain of 29dB and flat in response to within 1dB over a segment of 2 MHz centred on 71 MHz and a N.F. of approximately 2dB. The only changes necessary were to the coils!
