Oscar News

The club has received a letter from AMSAT-UK concerning the wide band, high-power transmission on 144.8 MHz. As mentioned in last months lecture, the transmission emanates from the University of Surrey near Guildford and is used to control OSCAR-6. The wideband transmission is necessary to overcome the effects of interference and Doppler shift. The transmission will be on for periods of 25 minutes repeating about every 100 minutes from 0530-2300 gmt, seven days a week. The control system is automatic and computer-controlled. Operators are asked to 'react sympathetically to any possible inconvenience'. Further information may be obtained from G3RWL, QTHR.
