## Next Meeting

This month your committee has tried to arrange something a little different - straight from Tomorrows World and Nationwide.

With the co-operation of ITT Basildon and the British Post Office the lecture is "Viewdata, with a demonstration of the Post Office's viewdata service - Prestel." The lecture will be given by Mr. Piers Hakluytt of ITT Consumer Products, Basildon. 26 inch colour TV sets will be used for the demonstration. These will be connected to the Prestel computer using a telephone line. The computer is now on-line 24 hours a day apart from occasional breakdowns; let's hope we don't get one. In any case a back-up demonstration will be provided on tape.

Chelmsford is going to have its own Prestel viewdata computer centre sometime in 1980, so the cost of local access will be about 2p per minute plus a cost per page varying from nothing to 10p. (For example, detailed stock market costing prices)

Viewdata is complementary to the information services transmitted by the BBC and IBA, CEEFAX and ORACLE respectively. These are off-air and receive only. Viewdata is on-line TV and as a Keyboard is provided it is interactive, i.e. two-way. Each user has to have a user code.

Why have your own microcomputer when you can have access to a GEC 4080 computer storing some 180,000 pages of information. Each computer will handle many hundreds of simultaneous users although at present there is only a handful.

Come along and see the new communication system. The meeting will be held at Marconi College, Arbour Lane, Chelmsford on Tuesday March 6th. commenting at 7:30pm.
