With the aid of the professional engineers, several transceivers were tested, VHF and HF. It was interesting to see the sidebands displayed on the screen and to see the spurious outputs of the equipment. It so happened that there were three of a particular make of 2 metre multimode portables, and each one had a "nasty" at about 134 MHz, obviously a design fault. Several of another 2 metre hand helds were tested, and all of them had excess deviation when speaking too close to the microphone. The evening was very interesting although owners were not able to give a talk about the equipment due to the change of rooms. Thanks go to Roy G3PMX and Les G4CUT and Dick G3WHR for arranging the evening.
